

About the VFW Military Assistance Program



The VFW Military Assistance Program (MAP) is the outstretched hand between the VFW and active duty, Guard, and Reserve military units. MAP offers grants to VFW Posts who participate in military unit functions, such as sponsoring "Farewell and Welcome Home Activities," "Family Readiness Group" events, or other sponsorship ideas.

MAP also links with VFW's Operation Uplink and Unmet Needs programs to create an all-star team of military assistance. MAP and Operation Uplink have provided more than 200 computers to set up Internet Cafes where service members' families may e-mail their deployed loved ones.

In addition, MAP has forged partnerships with various service providers, including www.vetjobs.com, aimed at providing the transitioning service member with relocation and employment assistance.

VFW Voice of Democracy Audio Essay Contest



Since 1947, the Voice of Democracy has been the VFW's premier scholarship program. Each year, more than 50,000 high school students compete for more than \$2.3 million in scholarships and incentives. Students compete by writing and recording a 3-5 minute broadcast script on an annual patriotic theme. Past notable winners include the late broadcast journalist Charles Kuralt, former Miss America Anita Bryant, and former U.S. Attorney General John Ashcroft.

The Voice of Democracy is open to students in grades 9-12, who are enrolled in a public, private or parochial high school or home study program in the United States, its territories and possessions; or in an overseas U.S. military/civilian dependent school.

Prizes and scholarships are awarded at the local, district, state and national level. Department (State) winners receive an all-expense paid trip to Washington, D.C., March 3-7, 2012, to tour the city, meet our nation's leaders, be honored by the VFW and its Ladies Auxiliary and receive their portion of \$151,000 in national awards, the top scholarship being \$30,000.

VFW Patriot's Pen Youth Essay Contest



Conducted by VFW Posts nationwide, the Patriot's Pen youth essay competition gives 6th, 7th, and 8th grade students an opportunity to write essays expressing their views on democracy with the prospect of winning cash scholarships and U.S. savings bonds. Winners at the local level have the prospects of being submitted to the national competition where contestants compete for over \$100,000 in U.S. Savings Bonds, in addition to prizes won at the local levels. The first-place national award is currently a \$10,000 savings bond plus an all-expense paid trip to Washington, D.C. for the winner and a parent or guardian.
